ERTHNXT KIDS PLANT 3,000 TREES THROUGH A DONATION FROM COMCAST IN GREATER PHILADELPHIA AND DELAWARE AREAS

Philadelphia, PA (April 30, 2009) – ERTHNXT, a Philadelphia-based national environmental education nonprofit announced today that with a generous donation from Comcast, it is helping children and youth from around the region connect to nature and protect the environment by planting 3,000 tree seedlings in areas needing reforestation.

ERTHNXT planted these trees with Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and other youth volunteers on April 4th at Delaware's Blackbird Creek State Reserve in Townsend, Delaware; April 18th at Milford Neck, Delaware in partnership with the Delaware Chapter of the Nature Conservancy; and will finish on May 2nd at Marsh Creek State Park in Downingtown, Pennsylvania with the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

"Tree planting is a great way to connect kids with nature. This donation from Comcast means that hundreds of children in the region will have a wonderful experience this spring, learning about trees and digging in the dirt," Janet Milkman, ERTHNXT President.

"We're happy to support ERTHNXT as it educates children about the importance of caring for nature," said Charisse R. Lillie, Vice President, Community Investment and Executive Vice President of the Comcast Foundation. "Similar to many of our Comcast Cares Day projects, planting these trees benefits and beautifies neighborhoods and contributes to the overall well-being of communities."

"I am excited about young people coming out to help us plant trees and get a hands-on feel for the trees, the soil, and the park itself," said Mike Kutzmonich, Assistant Manager of the French Creek Park Complex. "Ongoing stewardship from volunteers will help protect the future of the park's natural resources."

At each site, working with their land partners, ERTHNXT planted native tree species to help re-purpose former agricultural lands or build riparian buffers to improve water health and provide wildlife habitat. ERTHNXT will be planting more trees and educating children and youth organizations about the benefits of taking action for the environment this coming fall to share the Earth Day experience throughout the year.
